

With substantial Winter UK agricultural orders being delivered for the Spring, we are now waiting for the weather to improve for the equipment to get into full operation.

In the mean time, Nigel Palmer (Managing Director) is delighted that the Wright Rain Export business is continuing to develop this Spring.

- During March and April have recently delivered three large 55kw electric irrigation pump units to Nigeria as part of the first stages of a large Government funded agricultural development North West of Lagos and Nigel is looking forward to discussing the next stages for the supply of the system infrastructure during May.
- Having delivered a 60hp diesel engined pump unit on a wheeled chassis and integral fuel tank to Cameroon (West Africa) during February for irrigation by the Development Corporation, we are delighted to have been awarded a £60,000 contract to supply another four diesel pump units for delivery during June.
- After several weeks of design and discussion Wright Rain has been chosen to supply a £120,000 complete irrigation system for a new oil palm nursery in the Congo. The system incorporates two 225hp diesel engine pump units high pressure steel main piping and hand move sprinkler system on the nursery area as the first stage of the nursery development. This equipment should be delivered during June.
- Further supplies of equipment are currently being marshalled for an £18,000 spares order being shipped out to Nigeria for existing customers.

Many of the current orders are obtained from clients that know the Wright Rain company and their system design capabilities and experience ensuring that crucial systems operate as they are required.

Having supplied many major overseas projects over the last 50 years, Wright Rain is pleased that most of the original customers retain their links with the company and continue to order their new systems, spares and system extensions with confidence.
